Professionally Jillian works as both a dancer and circus artist. She has had the opportunity to perform with such companies as Ballet NY, Urban Ballet Theatre, AntiGravity Entertainment, José Mateo Ballet Theatre, Quixotic Fusion, Boston Ballet, AcroBack Productions, Aerial Artistry, NYC Tranzformerz Breakdance Crew, AcroArts Productions, BodyVox & Rebecca Rice Dance amongst others. Ms. St. Germain has experience in the tv/film industry as well, including as an aerialist/dancer on NBC's final season of their Primetime TV Series 'Smash' and in the Victoria's Secret Fashion Show aired on CBS. She also starred in award winning director & Pulitzer Prize winning photographer, Vincent LaForet's short film 'MōVI'.

In addition to performing Ms. St. Germain is passionate about choreographing and teaching. She has co-founded two multidisciplinary collaborative performance companies, most recently 3Names in 2015, where she has created everything from full length shows to event entertainment. Jillian has instructed dance and coached circus arts on the East Coast including NYC & Massachusetts, the Midwest, Alaska and most recently in Portland Oregon in arts organizations such as DaVinci Arts & BodyVox. She has experience teaching classes, workshops and private lessons, as well as act creation and choreography with students of all ages. Jillian is currently in the editing process of her debut as a film director in her film titled 'That Within Us Must Be Moved' which she created, choreographed, and directed.
